An athlete is defined as a person who is a member or licensee of a sports organization or an affiliated organization or who was a member at the time of a potential anti-doping rule violation, or who takes part in competitions organized by a sports organization or an affiliated organization supported by federal sports funding. Data Protection

Use of personal data
